What is the PAC (Parent Advisory Committee)?

The PAC was developed to involve families in our children's educational program. The PAC coordinates activities and organizes resources to help children, parents and the center's staff make the strong connection between home and the center. We encourage parents to visit and participate in center activities, as well as to support the center's teachers and staff. Each class will have a representative on the PAC, who serves as the "room parent" for each class.

What does the PAC do?

Your participation in your child's education is a special both for the children and teachers. The PAC works with your child's teacher to ask for parent volunteers for many activities and events throughout the year, such as field trips and holiday celebrations, as well as special events like celebrating the teacher's birthdays. Your child's PAC representative will coordinate any special activities that you would like to organize in advance with your child's teacher and the center director.

How is a PAC different than a board?

The PAC serves a supportive role in center operations; whereas, the decision making authority for center operations rests with the board.
